

## What Are the I-526 Choices?

Discussion about the **I-526 Extension** has been going on seemingly for decades. The longer it's talked about the more complex the issue becomes. Thirty-six alternate routes were considered by SC Department of Transportation, its consultants Wilbur-Smith and the Corps of Engineers. Those have been narrowed to eight.

Public hearings were held this spring so anyone interested could attend, view all the alternatives and have a representative from each of the firms answer questions and comments on a one-on-one basis.
