



usage, why wouldn't it have been done previously. If it's viable, then it should be done for profit. If the community wants to subsidize it, I think it is a normal, natural process. I would just say usage is important."

You need to think about proposed usage and how it's going to be funded. "I think we should give a lot of strong consideration to working with the Resort. It would be a very good option for residents," another resident said. Roberts said before the referendum last year, the Board approached Bill Goodwin (owner of Kiawah Island Golf Resort) and he wouldn't consider it.

Williams said, "Roger made a presentation you have to consider. Just to discount it is just wrong. There are other alternatives on our Island to meet our needs and we need to be bright about it. That's not fair to what Roger said."

The Board adjourned to Executive Session for discussions with an attorney who was on the phone.

On Friday, September 11, KICA sent an e-mail message to the membership saying: **The board is having discussions with the potential seller and when there is something definitive to report, the board will come back to members with further information. The board is committed to bringing this matter to members by referendum, should the price negotiations and other factors be positive.**

In the pre-meeting comments, a resident asked about the polo match KICA had scheduled for September 20

including a party at the Beach club to benefit the Conservancy. He asked for a report after the event to see what funds are going to the group.
